

ONE post-graduation work permit in their lifetime.

You must meet ALL of the following requirements to be eligible to apply for the PGW (Refer to [Eligibility criteria](#)).

- Must have completed a study program that was
 - o at least 8 months long and
 - o that led to a degree, diploma, or certificate.
- Must have maintained full-time study load in every semester (excluding scheduled breaks). There are exceptions for:
 - o Final academic semester: You can find details about taking part-time studies in your final academic semester [here](#).
 - o Authorized Leave of Absence: If you took an authorized leave of absence during studies, then it should be less than 150 days. We would also recommend speaking to one of the advisors at Camosun International before submitting your application. - Must apply for a PGW within 180 days

F Studies Outside Canada

All of the time you spent studying online at a PGWP-eligible DLI from outside Canada between March 2020 and August 31, 2022, counts toward the length of a PGWP. This policy was updated as of September 1, 2022.
